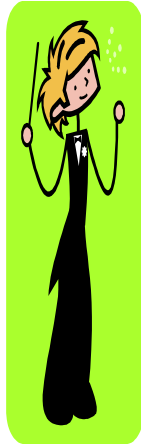


Girl's Cheerleading Practice
