

FAQ'S (Frequently Asked Questions)

Where is guest parking? Ample parking is available in our lot directly west of the building. Limited spaces are also available on Randolph directly in front of the school.

Where are the entrances? There are several openings to get to the church. Our church and school are one building.

If you park in the lot, the west door of the school is open prior to worship and you can simply walk through the upper hallway to the church.

If you park in front of the school, the north school door (by the flagpole) is open prior to worship and is handicap assessible. We have an elevator available at this entrance only.

What is the dress code? God wants you as you are.

What activities are there for my kids? Children worshipping with their parents are given "kid-based" bulletins that correspond to that Sunday's Bible readings. During Sept. - May, Sunday School (PK- Grade 6) is offered 9:45 a.m. after the Gospel Reading.

How do I join the church? Pastor Richy offers New Membership Classes (usually 6-8 weeks) which explains our beliefs and doctrine.

What denomination is your church affiliated with? We are affiliated with the Lutheran Church Missouri Synod. What time is the service and when should I arrive?

Sunday worship services begin 9:30 a.m. Both the west and north doors are open Sunday mornings at 8:00 a.m.

Advent (Nov.-Dec.) and Lenten (Feb. - April) Wednesday services are held 12:30 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. For the Wednesday services, you may arrive a half-hour prior to the start of the service.....using only the door by the flagpole.
